

SHORT CURRICULUM VITAE

Dr. Phivos Mylonas was born in Athens in 1978. He received his Diploma in Electrical and Computer Engineering from the National Technical University of Athens (NTUA) in 2001, his Master of Science (M.Sc.) in Advanced Information Systems from the National & Kapodestrian University of Athens (UoA) in 2003 and earned his Ph.D. degree (with distinction) at the former University (NTUA) in 2008. Since 2010 he has taught at numerous Greek universities, while from 2013 to 2022 he was initially Assistant Professor, then Associate Professor and finally Full Professor at the Department of Informatics of the Ionian University. Since 2023 he is currently a tenured **Associate Professor** by the Department of Informatics and Computer Engineering of the University of West Attica (UniWA) and collaborates as a Senior Researcher with the Intelligent Systems, Content and Interaction Laboratory, School of Electrical and Computer Engineering, Department of Computer Science of the National Technical University of Athens (NTUA), Greece.

His research interests include artificial intelligence and machine learning applications, content-based information retrieval, visual context representation and analysis, knowledge-assisted multimedia analysis, issues related to multimedia personalization, user adaptation, user modeling and profiling. He has published articles in **49** international journals and **43** book chapters, he is the co-author of **149** papers in international conferences and workshops, he has edited 10 books and is a guest editor of **20** international journals, he is a reviewer for **65** international journals and has been actively involved in the organization of **more than 160** international conferences and workshops. He is a member of the Technical Chamber of Greece since 2001, a member of the Hellenic Association of Mechanical & Electrical Engineers since 2002 and a member of W3C since 2009, whereas he is a past member of IEEE (1999-2010) and ACM (2001-2010, 2022-2023).
