for the Academic year 2024-25.
(Start of Courses: September, 30 2024)**

The Postgraduate Studies Program is organised by the Department of Informatics and Computer Engineering of the University of West Attica and operates in cooperation with foreign universities, in accordance with its foundation.

The aim of the program is to train graduates of universities and military schools, mainly of specialties of the broader field of Information Technology, who wish to acquire knowledge and skills in the field of Cyber Security and to form scientists who will staff public organizations, ministries and private sector companies and will contribute to the full protection of information systems from cyber attacks.

The duration is set at a minimum of three (3) academic semesters. The teaching is in English.

Postgraduate students pay a tuition fee of 2.900,00 €.

Applications

Candidates must submit the following documents:

- Application form. The application form can be retrieved from the website of the MSc.
- Copy of Undergraduate studies.
- Certificate of Analytical Grade.
- A certificate of proficiency in English (at least level C1) is required.
- A letter of intent, not exceeding 300 words, in which the applicant explains the reasons why he/she wishes to follow the MSc.

Candidates may also submit any other documentary evidence that they consider may support their choice, such as certificates of participation in conferences, special seminars, studies, etc.

Candidates' personal data are used exclusively for the purposes of the MSc and are safeguarded by the applicable provisions of the current legislation on the protection of personal data.

Submission starts on 25th of May 2024 and ends on 30th of June 2024.
